

**INDIVIDUAL INSTRUCTION**

Individual instruction shall be provided for those students who meet the following criteria:

1. Students are confined to their home, or to a hospital, by a physician because of illness or injury and when such confinement is expected to extend to a period of at least more than ten (10) school days;
2. Students are recommended to be placed on individual instruction by a child study team.
3. Students are in an indeterminate situation pending Board or administrative decision.
