

EQUIPMENT, BOOKS AND MATERIALS

The Board shall supply each teaching staff member with the supplies, materials and equipment necessary for the implementation of the approved program, and will also provide students with the supplies and materials they need for the successful completion of courses of study which are part of their assigned curriculum.

Exceptions to this policy shall be:

- A. Students will be requested to provide their own clothing or equipment where individualized and non-reusable clothing or equipment is required for reasons of safety, health or the protection of school property. These articles of clothing and/or equipment shall meet standards set by the school. Such standards shall be those reasonably related to considerations of safety, health and protection of property.
- B. Students may be required to pay the District the cost of the materials used when students prepare items which they are permitted to keep.
- C. The Board may require that students provide certain supplies and costs for the conduct of extracurricular activities.

The Superintendent shall ensure that no student will be denied participation in the school program for financial reasons while at the same time guarding the privacy of each student.
