

**BOND ELECTIONS**

---

The Board believes that the community will support bond issues for capital construction only if the voters have been thoroughly informed from the beginning.

Therefore, whenever the Board recognizes the approaching need for a bond election, the Superintendent shall develop materials and strategies to provide the public with all relevant facts pertaining to the bond issues. These may include, but not be limited to:

- A. Formation of citizens' advisory committees;
- B. Formation of speaker service;
- C. Development of flyers, fact sheets, etc.

The Board shall not expend public money to advocate its position on the bond issue, however.
