

County/Intermediate/State/Federal Units

The Board of Education (Board) directs the Chief School Administrator (CSA) to make all possible use of the resources and services offered by the regional curriculum services unit, educational services commissions, and other like agencies.

All resources and services shall be developed to ensure that the district and its staff comply with all state agency regulations.

The CSA shall keep all board members informed of pending congressional or legislative action that might affect funding for the district. Board members, acting as individuals and as a whole, will make their views known to their state and federal representatives and Senators and to the community at large, urging action to benefit schools.
