

TUITION INCOME

The district shall admit no pupils whose parents or legal guardians do not reside within the district except:

- A. As otherwise required by law;
- B. As arranged by inter-district agreement; or
- C. As admission is approved in individual cases by the Board.

Tuition shall be computed as provided by law.

However, pupils whose parents/guardians move from the district after April 1 may be allowed to conclude the remainder of their school year without payment of tuition upon recommendation of the Superintendent and approval of the Board of Education. The waiver of tuition charge shall be subject to revocation if the parent/guardian does not complete the necessary transfer procedure forms prior to June 1 of that same school year and provided the pupil's attendance does not decline or conduct becomes unacceptable. Should the pupil's attendance become irregular or conduct unacceptable, the principal shall have authority to require that the pupil withdraw from school. The student must stay in good standing with the school district.

The parent/guardian shall be responsible for all transportation costs.

In the case of enrollment in the Interdistrict Public School Choice Program, laws and regulations of the Interdistrict Public School Choice Program will be in effect through the term of the enrollment in said Program.
