

**NONINSTRUCTIONAL OPERATIONS**

The Board of Education recognizes the importance of business and non-instructional services to the operation of the school district and the achievement of district and school educational goals.

The Board directs the superintendent to ensure the provision of sufficient and appropriate services which may include, but are not limited to:

- A. Secretarial and clerical;
- B. Janitorial;
- C. Buildings and grounds maintenance;
- D. Food services; and
- E. Pupil transportation

Auxiliary services are essential to the successful functioning of a school system and management of such operations is an important responsibility. It should be remembered, however, that education is the district's central function, and all auxiliary services shall be provided guides and be evaluated accordingly.
