

**TRANSPORTATION**

The district shall provide transportation in the most economical manner consistent with safety for pupils who need it, qualify for it, and use it properly. Transportation shall be provided as required by law to eligible pupils attending non-public schools. Board-owned or contracted buses will transport only assigned pupils or other persons as authorized by the superintendent or designee.

The superintendent shall prepare rules and regulations to implement the program of transportation and control the proper conduct of pupils using such transportation.
