Competitive Food Sales

Competitive food sales are those from which the profits are not deposited to the account of the non-profit lunch programs. Any competitive food sales program must be approved by the Superintendent or designee.

Competitive food sales through vending machines or otherwise will be allowed only if they meet all of the following requirements:

- A. They take place only during the periods when lunch is not being served, with the exception of water machines.
- B. Access to competitive food and beverage items must not discourage pupils from participating in the regular lunch program. Parents/guardians expect lunch and/or breakfast money provided to the child to be used for the purchase of lunch and/or breakfast.
- C. Each principal is responsible for determining that competitive food sales do not jeopardize the federal lunch support.
- D. The number of vending machines at each school will be limited by the amount of building space not needed for regular purposes.
