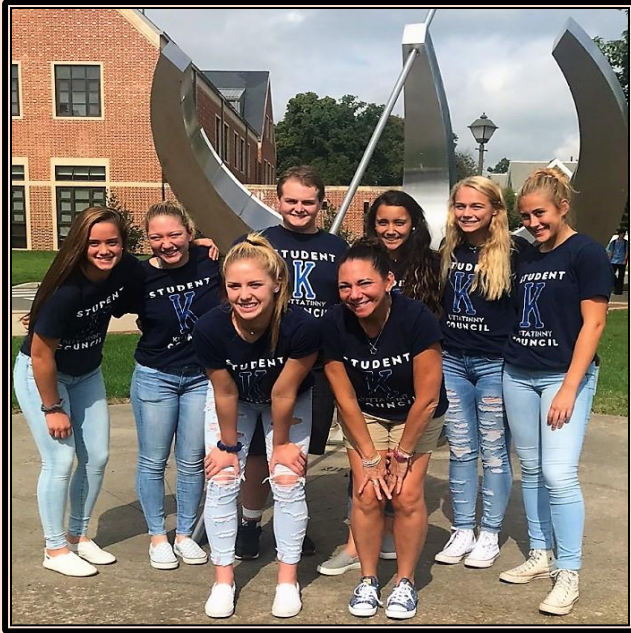


KRHS Student Council Attends 2018 NJASC Fall Conference
