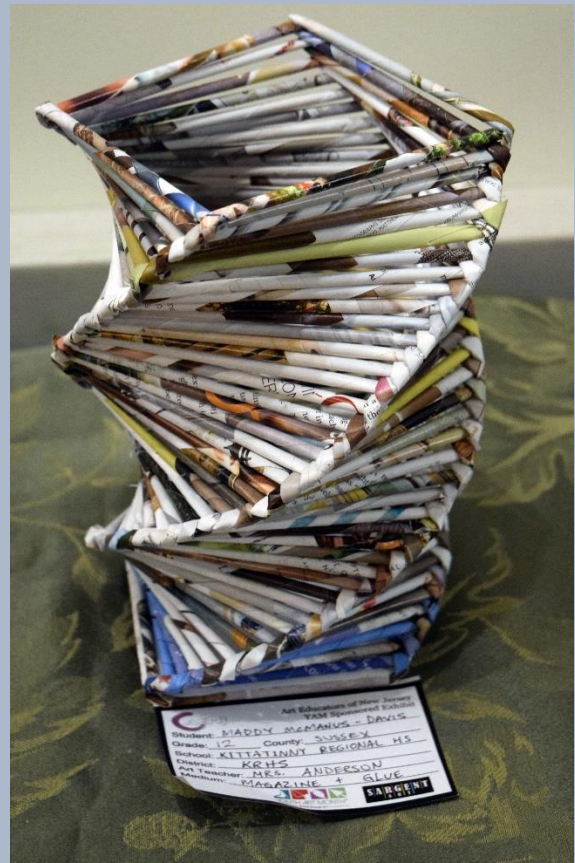

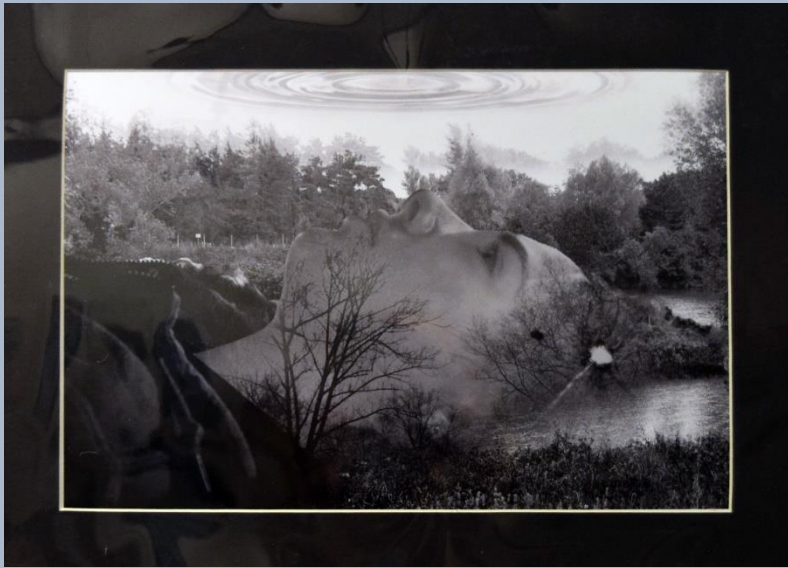


Hannah Horn's watercolor Night Owl.

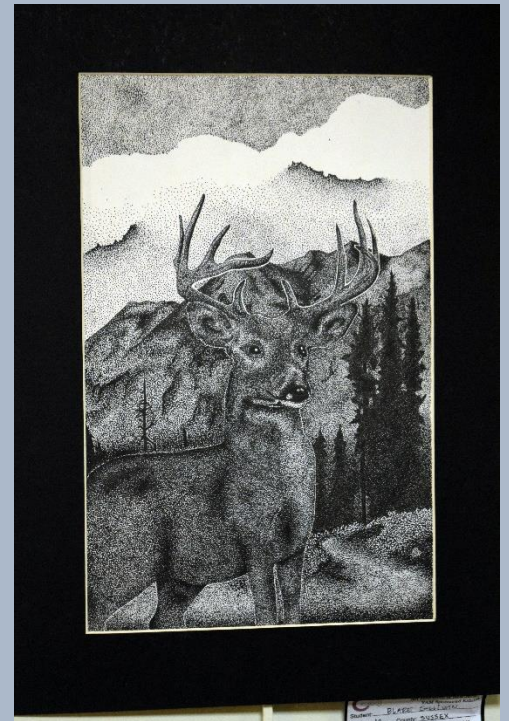

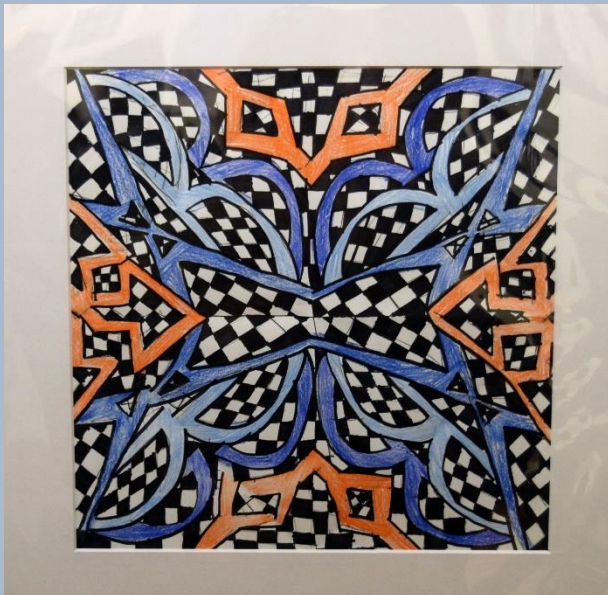
