

APPOINTMENT OF ATTORNEY

The Board of Education (Board) attorney shall, upon the request of the Board:

1. Advise the Board as to the proper legal and contractual procedures in which the Board must take action or make a decision;
2. Be accessible for consultation with the Chief School Administrator, School Business Administrator/Board Secretary and the Board President concerning legal matters;
3. Act as counsel for the Board in prosecuting or defending any action or suit to which the Board is party; and
4. Perform such other special legal services as the Board may from time to time prescribe.
