

ORGANIZATION MEETING

The Board of Education shall organize annually at a regular meeting held for that purpose on any day of the first week in January following the annual school election in November.

The meeting shall be called to order by the Board Secretary, who shall preside until such time as a president is elected. Election results shall be read and new Board members sworn in and a president and vice president elected. Following election of officers, the Board shall:

- A. Appoint or confirm appointment of the Board Secretary;
- B. Adopt policies and approve regulations of previous Board. This blanket adoption of policies enacted by previous Boards and current administrative regulations shall be with stipulation that Board may amend and supplement Board policies, including those establishing its own bylaws and operational procedures;
- C. Name depositories and signatories for school funds;
- D. Appoint the treasure of school moneys;
- E. Appoint Board auditor, attorney, medical inspector, insurance broker and any other appropriate officials;
- F. Set or reaffirm regular meeting dates for the year and newspapers through which notice shall be given;
- G. Address committee assignments for the coming year;
- H. Reaffirm any contractual commitments as appropriate at the wish of the Board;
- I. Appoint a member to serve as delegate to NJ School Boards Association and another to serve as alternate;
- J. Appoint a member to serve as delegate to the Sussex County School Boards Association.

The Board may then adjourn or proceed into a duly called meeting.
